

SAP® Cloud Platform, SAP ASE Service

The SAP® ASE service on SAP Cloud Platform is measured in instances. An instance is a single instantiation of the service running during a month.



USE CASE:

Your company plans to use an X-small instance (1 core, 4 GB RAM, 32 GB disk space, 512 GB/month bandwidth out, unlimited bandwidth in) for the development of a proof of concept. The service is activated on January 17 and deactivated on March 6. On February 11, a medium instance (4 cores, 16 GB RAM, 160 GB disk space, 512 GB/month bandwidth out, unlimited bandwidth in) is activated and deactivated on April 15. This medium instance is used for testing. The development instance runs in parallel.



CHARGES:

JANUARY	1 X-small instance €500 = €500
FEBRUARY	1 X-small instance €500 + 1 medium instance €1,000 = €1,500
MARCH	1 X-small instance €500 + 1 medium instance €1,000 = €1,500
APRIL	1 medium instance €1,000 = €1,000
TOTAL	€4,500

Consumption enablement: Charging is directly linked to the number of instances. By managing the instances, the customer enables and controls the consumption.
